Enlisting with the Terran Federation, idealistic Juan "Johnny" Rico undergoes a brutal indoctrination into military discipline, eventually commanding his own platoon. When the Bugs make a devastating attack on Earth, however, it becomes personal for Rico, and a galaxy-wide war erupts. "Starship Troopers is compelling reading. And it's not just the difficult nature of [Robert] Heinlein's politics that makes it so. There's a force to much of the writing and a clarity of vision that elevate this book.
